The GBI Crime Laboratory continues to review sexual assault evidence in storage that was submitted prior to 1999 in order to identify cases that have the potential to undergo DNA analysis. Approximately 12 of these cases remain that need DNA analysis based on requests from law enforcement or prosecuting agencies.
