O.C.G.A. § 35-1-2 (g) requires the Division of Forensic Sciences to provide an annual report of the number of sexual assault cases for which it has tested evidence pursuant to this Code section and the number of sexual assault cases remaining to be tested. **SB304 Kits:** Sexual assault kits with incident dates prior to 2015 as well as submissions of sexual assault kits previously being stored at hospitals are included in the SB304 statistics. Testing has been completed on these SB304 kits.

The GBI Crime Laboratory reviewed sexual assault evidence in storage that was submitted prior to 1999 to identify cases that have the potential to undergo DNA analysis. Sexual assault evidence from 2,115 cases have been identified that need DNA analysis based on a review by the GBI Crime Laboratory and requests from law enforcement or prosecuting agencies.
