GBI CRIME LAB OPERATIONS BULLETIN 2024-01 NEW SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR FIREARMS EVIDENCE March 26, 2024

The GBI Crime Lab provides the criminal justice system with high quality service and support. To maintain a safe and efficient laboratory environment, the GBI Crime Lab will implement the following change to requirements for the submission of firearms to our laboratories.

Effective **June 1, 2023, per Operations Bulletin 2023-01**, all firearms (handguns and long guns) were required to be submitted in commercially available gun boxes **with clear windows** that will allow the viewing of the contents.

Effective immediately, the requirement to submit **long guns** (rifles and shotguns) in boxes with windows is changed to make boxes without windows also acceptable. ALL HANDGUNS MUST STILL BE SUBMITTED IN BOXES WITH WINDOWS PER OPERATIONS BULLETIN 2023-01.

Please continue to follow all other guidance in Operations Bulletin 2023-01, including proper zip tie use. Please ensure the gun is zip tied to the box in a position such that the chamber can be viewed through the window to verify the handgun is not loaded without opening the box.

- Do not submit a loaded firearm to the crime laboratory. IF you cannot unload it, please notify a laboratory staff member when you arrive.
- Slides on handguns must be locked open and the gun zip tied to demonstrate the unloaded condition.
- The magazine must be removed from all handguns and fastened separately to the box bottom with a zip tie. It is acceptable to leave cartridges in the magazine.
- If loose cartridges are being submitted in the box with the gun, they MUST be contained in a **separate** sealed package within the box.
- **Do not package recovered cartridge cases or bullets** in the same box as a gun. They must be submitted separately.

We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain safe crime laboratories and to make our evidence submission process more efficient.
