

**To whom it may concern:**

1) To be considered valid under the Official Code of Georgia Annotated (OCGA), the chemical analysis of a person's breath shall have been performed according to methods approved by the Division of Forensic Sciences and by an individual possessing a valid permit issued by the Division of Forensic Sciences.

2) Pursuant to the provisions of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated (OCGA), Rules of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation Chapter 92-3 Implied Consent have been promulgated.

3) Pursuant to Chapter 92-3, 92-3-.06(5) and 92-3-.06(12(a)(1)), Intoxilyzer™ 5000 Serial Number \_\_\_\_\_ is authorized for use at (agency name and address) / in (vehicle make, model, tag number) \_\_\_\_\_ when maintained with all its parts attached and in good working order as prescribed by the manufacturer and in accordance with Chapter 92-3 effective (date) \_\_\_\_\_ and continuing until the instrument is placed on inactive status by the Division of Forensic Sciences.

4) This instrument is approved for breath alcohol testing by any valid permit holder when the test is conducted in accordance with OCGA and Chapter 92-3; however the agency to which the instrument is assigned shall retain the right to determine who shall be allowed access to the instrument for use. Notwithstanding the Georgia Bureau of Investigation reserves the right to access the aforementioned instrument to perform any function necessary to execute its duties pursuant to Chapter 92-3 and failure to grant such access shall result in the revocation of instrument approval.

5) The agency to which the instrument is assigned is responsible for ensuring that the instrument is maintained as prescribed by the manufacturer in accordance with OCGA and Chapter 92-3 and shall be responsible for ensuring that the instrument has received a valid inspection prior to use. Failure to properly maintain the instrument or removal of the instrument from its designated testing location without the authorization of the Division of Forensic Sciences may result in the revocation of instrument approval.
