Sexual Assault Kits Report November 30, 2018

O.C.G.A. § 35-1-2 (g) requires the Division of Forensic Sciences to provide an annual report of the number of sexual assault cases for which it has tested evidence pursuant to this Code section and the number of sexual assault cases remaining to be tested. The table below provides this information.

SB304 Kits: Sexual assault kits with incident dates prior to 2015 as well as submissions of sexual assault kits previously being stored at hospitals are included in the SB304 statistics. Testing has been completed on these SB304 kits.

Ongoing Investigations: The GBI Crime Laboratory receives approximately 250 new sexual assault kits each month from ongoing investigations.

The GBI Crime Laboratory continues to review sexual assault evidence in storage that was submitted prior to 1999 in order to identify cases that have the potential to undergo DNA analysis. Approximately 1,310 of these cases were outsourced based on requests for analysis from law enforcement or prosecuting agencies.
