The GBI has received its FY2011 budget and instructions from the Governor's Office on implementation of the budget. The GBI Crime Lab in Moultrie will remain closed and the crime laboratory in Columbus will be closed within 90 days after July 1, 2010. All available funding will be utilized to effectively run the laboratory system and continue to provide the forensic services that you require at our remaining facilities.

The GBI Crime Lab System will continue to prioritize services as needed upon request from law enforcement or prosecuting offices to ensure critical investigative or court requirements are met.
